

2020 Keep Suffolk Beautiful Photo Calendar Contest Entry Form

The calendar contest provides an opportunity to highlight the beauty and splendor of the City of Suffolk. Please review rules below before completing submission form at bottom of this page.

Official Contest Rules: No purchase, payment or entry fee is necessary to enter or win. The City of Suffolk reserve the right to use all entries for print, promotional materials, presentations and online and are released from any liability.

Contest Period: All entries to the 2020 Keep Suffolk Beautiful Photo Calendar Contest (the "Contest") must be submitted by 11:59 pm Eastern Time, August 24, 2019.

Eligibility: The Contest is open to all amateur and professional artists/photographers, adults and youth. City of Suffolk employees and their immediate family members are not eligible.

What to Enter: All photographs must be taken in the City of Suffolk. Photographers may submit up to three (3) photographs in landscape orientation for consideration. Each photo must be in digital format between 8-20 megapixels (minimum 2550 x 3300 pixels), high resolution (300dpi) and be in the JPEG, JPG, or GIF format. Each photo must be submitted with separate entry form. No print or film submissions will be accepted. Photos may be in color or black and white. Photographs of Suffolk parks, events, trails, athletic facilities, public spaces, and waterways will strongly be considered.

How to Enter: Each photo must be submitted with a completed entry form available online. Submissions should be emailed to: suffolkartleague@verizon.net

Judging: Official judging will be performed by a panel consisting of Director of The Suffolk Art League, Director of Suffolk Tourism and Manager of the Suffolk Art Gallery. Winners will be notified by September 14th, 2019.

Contest Prize: The judging panel will select a minimum of twelve (12) winning photographs to be published in the 2020 Keep Suffolk Beautiful Calendar. Each winning photographer will receive a prize of \$50, regardless of number of winning entries.

General Conditions: The City of Suffolk will not be responsible for incomplete, lost, or late entries, all of which will be disqualified. The City of Suffolk further reserves the right to disqualify any entry that is alleged to infringe on any third-party's intellectual property or other rights. Digitally or otherwise enhanced or altered photos may not be considered. Minor adjustments including sharpening, contrast and slight color adjustments are acceptable. Winners of photos including recognizable people or those emphasizing another person's work (i.e. statue, painting, etc.) may be asked to submit a release form, see sample. Winners will need to submit any necessary release forms within 14 days of notification; failure to provide necessary documentation by the deadline may result in disqualification and selection of substitute winners. The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received and the judges' scoring of those entries.

As a condition of having a photograph selected as a winning image, photographers agree to a non-exclusive transfer of worldwide rights.
